

The Bare Teeth of the Pro-Abortion Movement

As thinking Christians, we must never down play the vital importance of our democracy and election. We as Christians have an utmost responsibility to vote as a good steward with Christian conviction and conscience. However, we must never believe that a political conquest will shelter ultimate and or any lasting peace. We need not a radical political crusade, but a biblical centered, Christ exalating, truth defending, God fearing, Spirit illuminated, error refuting, passion ignited, world rejecting protest! That is a call back *to* and commitment *to* let God's words speak. At the heart of the debate that rages around the world is abortion: Is it really a matter of life and death?

The radical pro-abortion movement has sown a culture of death. It attempts to destroy and to deny the sanctity of life, and the consequences are now very clear to see. I want to make known that this is exactly what happens when a society jettisons the moral code which is based on objective truth. That truth is this - every human is an expansion of the Lord's common grace, and an image bearer of God. As Christians, let us remember that there is no middle ground on this issue. The Bible never teaches 'middle-ground', you are saved or you are not saved. In philosophy it's called the *Law of the Excluded Middle*. Jesus used the *Law of the Excluded Middle* in Matthew 12:30, "He who is not with Me is against Me." The bare teeth of the proabortion movement and the death grip of the Democratic Party amounts to the murder of an unborn child.

We are fallen from that image, yes, but that image still resides and sets us apart! God's word is over the government and it teaches that our humanity began at the moment of conception.
