

A world at war With Christ.

The bible, as well as history is under attack. There is an attempt to redefine words, history and scripture. All of this is on full display in a recent CNN article. It's called "an imposter christianity is threatening American democracy. Right off the bat they claim that it was Christians who were responsible for the January 6th ordeal in D.C.. that's pretty funny I must have overlooked the guy with the buffalo horns in this morning's services. It's a ridiculous charge. But they have readers that will fall for this stuff.

Then they talk about their so-called experts that advocate for the separation of Church and state. Just within that statement alone, I know that the only thing they could possibly be experts at is either socialist propaganda or ignorance. First the separation of Church and state is not in our constitution. The only time this is mentioned is in the federalist papers. The federalist papers are not legal papers but rather explain how our republic is supposed to work. Thomas Jefferson was saying that the constitution would be the wall of separation that would prevent the government from stopping, regulating or dictating the worship of any group or individual. It doesn't mean you cannot pray or have a bible, let alone a bible study, on government property. These so-called experts are lying about our founding documents.

It is no different when it comes to our constitution. They take offense towards it because it is based on biblical principles. Since I mentioned the 2nd amendment I will use that as an example. **Exo 22:2** "If the thief is caught while breaking in and is struck so that he dies, there will be no bloodguiltiness on his account. **Luk 22:36** And He said to them, "But now, whoever has a money belt is to take it along, likewise also a bag, and whoever has no **sword** is to sell his coat and **buy** one.

Taking a careful look at these two passages we can see that we have the Right, given by God to defend both life and property. Exo 20:13 "You shall not murder.

Exo 20:15 "You shall not steal.

Exo 20:16 "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
