Noah overcame because, "*Noah was perfect in his generation, and Noah walked with God*" (Gen 6:9). Noah guarded the truth and stood up against it when his culture despised it. The point is this, the church needs to wake up! The more outrageous everyone is in sin, the more courageous we should be for truth. We should be the holiest in evil times (Matt. 5:47, 2 Cor. 6:17).
